About the Trainee Program:

Governed by members of the DGA and the AMPTP, the Assistant Director Training Program selects a small number of high-quality, diverse candidates from hundreds of applicants each year and trains them to be DGA Second Assistant Directors. The DGA Trainees are thoroughly vetted through a rigorous selection process and instructed in the latest industry techniques and methods.

Advantages of hiring DGA Trainees:

- These highly qualified candidates are trained by established DGA members and AMPTP Studio representatives on a range of topics including: Preparing Production Reports, Creating Call Sheets, First Aid, Safety on Set, Setting Background Actors, Processing Vouchers, and SAG-AFTRA, IATSE and Teamsters contracts.
- Hiring a DGA Trainee is a great way to stretch production dollars. Under the supervision of an Assistant Director, Trainees can perform a range of DGA sanctioned duties that far exceed those performed by Production Assistants.
- The Plan will reimburse up to 50% of a Trainee's transportation, per diem and housing costs while on distant location, nationally or internationally. For work on distant location, Trainees fly coach and, if unworked, they are not owed 6th and 7th day pay. Trainee per diem is also negotiable and monies can be deducted for meals that are provided by the Employer.
